Result of thought experiment: In the absence of any resistive effects, all objects will fall at the same rate.

* regardless of mass

* all objects gain velocity at the same rate

* acceleration due to gravity:
 * on the earth's surface

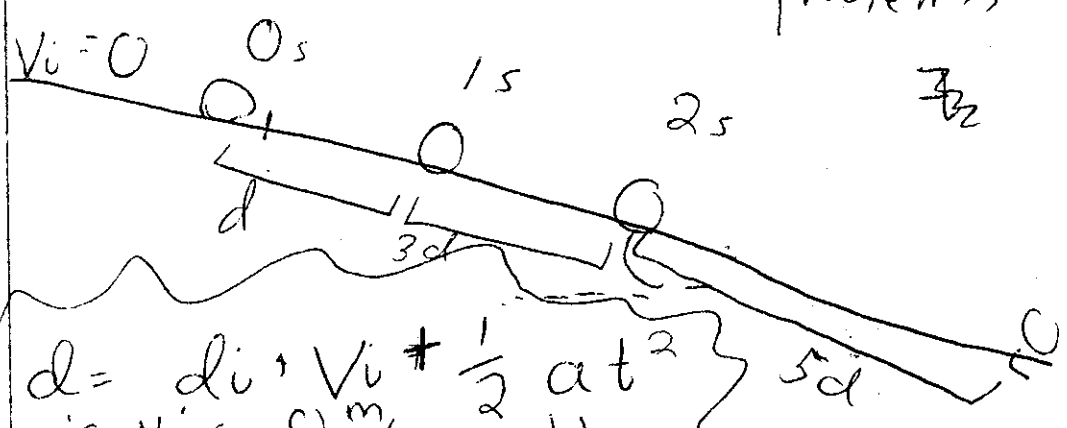
$$g = 9.80$$

HOW TO CREATE EMPATHY IN PERSEPOLIS

- Real from her perspective } Personal (STAN)
- violence/horror → simplicity of images (DARNEIL)
 - childs perspective
- (51) Grandfather story of torture (AMBER)
 - visual images of torture, pain
 - facial reaction reveals/shows emotions
- (18) Black background, contrast from other cells, sets apart
 - dichotomy visually between good & evil
 - reveals nuance
- Protestors: when people continue to protest against army
 - reveals courage
 - reveals organization
- childish tone: can't feel anything but empathy for child.
